



October 4, 2014: Spring Street Run YOUR COMMUNITY BANK

Arrival and Parking: Race starts at 10:30. Spring Street will be closed from Eleventh to Bank Street for our race. Please avoid this route. The staging area for runners will be located on the parking lot behind the Carnegie Center which will be accessible by foot only. Runners may enter the parking lot no earlier than 9:30 am and should remain with their parents until they check in with their coach. Any runners arriving downtown before 9:30 a.m. must remain with their parents and off of the streets. Runners may not leave the area until dismissed by their coach. See dismissal below.

We encourage you to carpool. Below is a list of businesses and churches that have permitted our use of their parking lots on October 4th. The lots should be free, but they are also open to the public as well as NATC runners. Street parking and other locations are also available. To alleviate everyone attempting to park in the same location, we have suggested parking locations assigned by each school below. Please attempt to use your designated lot before attempting to park in another lot identified below. Also be respectful not to block any ATMs; do not park in restricted areas; and do not leave trash.

- MainSource Bank located on State Street between Market and Spring Street. (51 spots)—Greenville
- St. Marks Church—Left off of Market Street on East Third Street (72 spots)—Mt. Tabor/Green Valley
- St. Marks Church overflow—Left off of Market St. on Bank St. Parking on right (20 spots)— Mt. Tabor/Green Valley
- Rodefer Moss—Left off of Elm on E. Third St. (35 spots)—Slate Run
- Centenary United Methodist Ch.—Elm and Third St. Enter off of Elm Street past Third St. (85 spots)—Grantline/SEJ
- PNC Bank—Main lot is off of State St. near Spring St. (55 spots) and overflow lot behind Circle K off of State St. (20 spots)—Georgetown and Christian Academy
- Garage—Corner of Market and State Street. Enter from either Market or State Street. (261 spots)—FKE/Fairmont/SIC/General.
- Overflow from YMCA between Bank and Pearl near the flood wall (70+ spots)—General
- Street parking on Market Street and surrounding streets—General

Pre-Race: The race will start at 10:30. Arrive with plenty of time to park and check in. Pre race meetings will be at 10:10. Once runners check in with their coach they will not move from this location until they walk to the starting line as a group. Runners will return to the same location and will not leave until dismissed by their coach. Runners should use the restroom prior to arriving downtown. Limited port-a-potties available for the HH parade within walking distance.

Race: Depending on race day numbers we will go with a two or three-race format. The race will begin in front of the Carnegie Center on Spring St. Runners will head East on Spring St. until Eleventh Street. The course turns around at Eleventh Street and will head back (West) on Spring Street toward the finish at Spring and Bank Streets. Runners will again be funneled back in the staging area on Bank Street and Sprigler parking lot.

Awards: Awards will be a little different than normal. Awards will be given to (1) top finishers; (2) special awards for other individuals for other positive achievement during the season; (3) “graduating” fourth graders will all be recognized as well as anyone participating in Marathon Club. No team awards. Awards will be in the adjacent Sprigler parking lot behind the Carnegie Center which is accessible via foot traffic only by the Bank Street sidewalk and alley. Parents will be asked to pick up their child in this Carnegie Center parking lot. Please make sure to check with your child’s coach before leaving as all runners will be required to remain in the parking area until they are picked up.

Rain: If there is a light rain and we can safely run the race we will do so. Heavy rain and lightning may cause us to cancel the race. If inclement weather requires race cancellation we will make the determination Saturday morning and post the information on the NATC webpage, Facebook, and Twitter as soon as the decision has been made.
